If you get a call,

*"Their Call" - "Thanks for the contact", Please Copy 3A (or 3 alpha),
OK" or (Three Alpha, OK (OSCAR KILO)*

Ask for their Station Designator and Log It in the log sheet.

Thanks again for the contact.....

*No Need to wait.....move on to the next station.....every contact is a
point.....*

CQ Field Day, CQ Field Day, CQ Field Day, this is W5DRZ CQ Field Day!

Wait a second or two, then call again

If you get a call,

*"Their Call" - "Thanks for the contact", Please Copy 3A (or 3 alpha),
OK"*

Ask for their Station Designator and Log It in the log sheet.

Thanks again for the contact.....

*There is a way to be competitive without being rude.....Stay on task
and keep moving with contacts.....*
